



GRADING STANDARDS

REVISED HAY QUALITY GUIDELINE FOR NATIONWIDE MARKET NEWS REPORTING

Livestock and Grain Market News branch has revised the hay quality guidelines for use in the nationwide Market News reporting program. These revised guidelines establish specific objective measurements of value attributes for each quality category of Alfalfa hay. The revised guidelines include all parameters commonly used to measure hay quality and also have all parameters in proper relationship to each other.

Nationwide uniformity of price information is the goal of revising these guidelines for quality designations. It is important for hay buyers in any part of the United States to be able to read any of USDA's hay reports and know the hay prices quoted are consistent from area to area for quality - so that producers and buyers from different areas, can be talking about hay in the report and feel confident they are talking about the same quality.

The following are the revised national hay guidelines on Alfalfa. Guidelines are also included for Grass Hay. Reporters will be using test parameter(s) prominent in their trade area, visual characteristics, as well as the intent of sale (usage) to determine hay quality.

Hay Quality Designation's physical descriptions:

Supreme: Very early maturity, pre-bloom, soft fine-stemmed, extra leafy. Factors indicative of very high nutritive content. Hay is excellent color and free of damage.

Premium: Early maturity, i.e., pre-bloom in legumes and pre-head in grass hays, extra leafy and fine-stemmed factors indicative of a high nutritive content. Hay is green and free of damage.

Good: Early to average maturity, i.e., early- to mid-bloom in legumes and early head in grass hays, leafy, fine to medium stemmed, free of damage other than slight discoloration.

Fair: Late maturity, i.e. mid- to late-bloom in legumes, head-in grass hays, moderate or below leaf content, and generally coarse-stemmed. Hay may show light damage.

Utility: Hay in very late maturity, such as mature seed pods in legumes or mature head in grass hays, coarse-stemmed. This category could include hay discounted due to excessive damage and heavy weed content or mold. Defects will be identified in market reports when using this category.



BY-LAWS OF IDAHO HAY & FORAGE ASSOCIATION, INC.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this association shall be the "Idaho Hay & Forage Association, Inc."

ARTICLE II - PRINCIPLE PURPOSE

The purpose of the Idaho Hay & Forage Association, Inc. is to promote the welfare of the hay and forage industry in the State of Idaho.

ARTICLE III - OBJECTIVES

- 1. Develop a coordinated, unified, statewide hay and forage program.
- 2. Establish a uniform grading system for all hay and forage marketed in the State of Idaho.
- 3. Acquire, preserve and disseminate useful information pertinent to the hay and forage industry.
- 4. Develop an Idaho State Hay and Forage Directory for the purpose of promoting the hay and forage industry both in and out of the State of Idaho.
- 5. Encourage research, testing and educational programs for the benefit of the Idaho hay and forage industry.
- 6. Be actively involved in all legislative matters pertaining to the hay and forage industry.

ARTICLE IV - MEMBERSHIP AND DUES

Section 1. REGULAR MEMBERSHIP: The Idaho Hay & Forage Association shall be open to persons, partnerships and corporations engaged in the production of hay and/or forage in Idaho. Regular members, if current in their payment of dues, shall be entitled to one vote. Annual dues will be set by the board of directors.

Section 2. ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP: Businesses and corporations not involved in the production of hay and/or forage, but associated with the industry, may join the Idaho Hay & Forage Association as associate members. The board of directors will set annual dues and associate members do not hold voting privileges in the association.

Section 3. Associate members may contribute any amount in excess of their annual membership dues that they wish each year. Contributions in excess of annual membership dues will be placed in a special fund that can only be allocated by the board of directors for education and/or research.

ARTICLE V - BOARD AND OFFICERS

Section 1. BOARD OF DIRECTORS:

- a. The business of this association shall be governed and guided by a board of directors of not less than five (5) not more than fifteen (15).
- b. Members of the board must be current association members. Board members shall be elected for two (2) year terms by membership at the annual meeting. The elections will be staggered so that not all terms expire in the same year.
- c. The board shall be elected from the membership-at-large.
- d. The University of Idaho College of Agricultural and Life Sciences and the Idaho State Department of Agriculture will be invited to submit the name of an individual to serve as an ex-officio member of the board. These members will serve for a two (2) year term.
- e. The chairman of the Idaho Farm Bureau Federation Hay and Forage Commodity Committee may be invited to serve as a board member with voting privileges. The appointment will be for a term of one year.
- f. The vendors displaying at the IHFA Annual Meeting will be provided a nomination form in their packet which is to be completed prior to the close of the annual meeting. The names on the ballots will be submitted to the board of directors for consideration of an industry representative to be appointed to the board of directors. The names submitted must be residents of Idaho. The appointment will be for a term of two years. The industry representative will have voting privileges on the board.
- g. The board of directors shall meet following the annual meeting and elect the president, vice president, secretary and treasurer.
- h. Vacancies on the board of directors may be appointed by the board until the next annual meeting.
- i. The board of directors shall have the power to appoint or hire one or more qualified persons as it deems necessary for the operation of the association.
- j. For the board to conduct business at any called meeting, a simple majority of the elected board of directors must be present. Any action of the board must be approved by a majority of those present at said meeting.
- k. A board member who is going to be absent from a board meeting must notify the IHFA office in advance of the

meeting. A board member missing two consecutive meetings of the IHFA Board of Directors without being listed as absent and excused will be eligible for replacement by the remaining board of director members.

Section 2. POWERS: The board of directors is empowered to develop and enter into contracts in connection with the purpose of this association. The board of directors shall oversee all Association finances.

Section 3. OFFICERS:

- a. The officers of the board shall be: president, vice president, secretary and treasurer and other officers, as deemed necessary. These officers shall be members of the board of directors of the association. These officers shall hold until their successors are duly elected.
- Duties of the officers elected by this association's board of directors shall be established by board policy and updated by said board as needed.
- c. The president shall serve for a one-year term. This office shall be filled by a member of the board who has served for at least one year. Should the office of president become vacant prior to the end of the term, the board of directors shall elect a president to serve the reminder of the term until the next annual meeting of the association.
- d. Any other vacancy in the officers of the association shall be appointed by the board of directors for the remainder of said officer's term.
- e. The two offices of secretary and treasurer may be combined into one office of secretary-treasurer at the discretion of the board of directors

Section 4. SALARIES:

- a. No officers or director of the association shall be entitled to any salary.
- b. The expenses for board of directors who are involved in representation of the association will be reimbursed at the established rate and with prior board authorization.

Section 5. EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE:

- a. The executive committee shall consist of the president, vice president, secretary and treasurer.
- b. By majority vote of the board of directors, the affairs or business of the association may be conducted by the executive committee.

ARTICLE VI - MEETINGS

Section 1. An annual meeting of the association shall be held each year, the location and date to be determined by the board of directors, with prior notice given to all Idaho hay and forage producers.

Section 2. The board of directors shall have the right to call a special meeting at any time, or twenty-five (25) percent of the members may file a petition with the president and/or secretary stating the specific business to be brought before the association and request a special meeting at any time. Such meetings shall be called by the president and the secretary.

Section 3. Notice of all membership meetings, together with a statement of the purposes for said meetings, shall be mailed to each member at least ten (10) days prior to the meeting.

Section 4. The board of directors shall have the power to set board meetings as needed. Special meetings of the board of directors shall be held upon call of the president or upon written request of a majority of the directors.

Section 5. At all meetings of the association, the following order of business shall be observed so far as consistent with the purposes of the meeting:

- 1. Call to Order
- 2. Reading of Minutes
- 3. Report of the President
- 4. Report of the Treasurer
- 5. Report of the Secretary
- 6. Election of Directors
- 7. Unfinished Business
- 8. New Business
- 9. Adjournment

ARTICLE VII - AMENDMENTS

The by-laws may be amended by a majority vote of the current members present at any regular or special meeting of the association provided that the nature and intent of the amendment(s) has been stated in a letter to the membership, or in the official bulletin of the association, at least ten (10) days prior to the date of the meetings.

IHFA LEGISLATIVE POLICIES

Agriculture Research/Education

Agriculture in the Classroom - AITC:

We support the program "Idaho Ag in the Classroom" in Idaho elementary schools. We encourage the purchase of agriculture license plates by Idaho residents. All funds generated through the purchase and renewal of the plates are designated to the Idaho AITC program. We further support legislative funding through the Idaho State Department of Agriculture, Administrative Budget, for the operations of this program. We support the maintenance of AITC in the structure of USDA to offer leadership and coordination of this program across the US.

Cooperative Extension/Outreach System:

We support funding at a federal, state and local level for the Cooperative Extension System and support further services and methods of communication which will enable rural agriculture producers and their families to receive the latest in technology, education and information. We further support the mainten-ance of a strong agriculture component in the Extension/Outreach System to serve the needs of rural Idaho and production agriculture.

Funding for R & E Centers in Idaho:

We support on-going allocation of general fund money for the Research and Extension (R & E) Centers in Idaho. We recognize the importance of quality equipment and necessary repairs to these centers in order to facilitate the research and education they provide. We further encourage strong cooperation between agriculture organizations and commodity groups to increase legislative awareness and participation in the funding of these improvements.

Environmental Issues

Food Quality Protection Act – FQPA:

We support the efforts by Food Producers of Idaho, the Idaho Congressional Delegation, U of I the chemical industry and the Idaho State Department of Agriculture in compiling factual information related to chemical use in agriculture. We support efforts to delay further implementation of restrictions on use of chemicals by EPA until actual chemical use data has been obtained. We further support that USDA become more involved in the FQPA review and implementation on behalf of agriculture producers in the US. We encourage full support of Idaho agricultural chemical dealers in providing use data to the Minor Crop Alliance Committee to aid in compiling actual chemical use data.

Noxious Weeds in Idaho:

We support funding from the general fund and through a broad assessment of all citizens of Idaho to generate funds to control and combat noxious weeds on all Idaho lands. We support the establishment of Noxious Weed Management Areas in Idaho and that aggressive action

should be taken by these NWMA for the control and elimination of noxious weeds. We further support annual reporting by the Noxious Weed Advisory Board to the state legislature on the progress and costs of controlling noxious weeds in the Gem State.

Funding for Noxious Weed Control in Idaho:

We support reinstatement of the \$1.00/tire tax on all tires (except for recaps) sold in Idaho as a method of funding a Noxious Weed Control Fund to provide necessary monies for fighting and controlling noxious weeds in our state. We recommend that this fund should be on going with annual financial reports submitted to a germane committee of the Senate and House Agriculture Affairs Committee. We support that this tire assessment be collected and administered through the Idaho State Department of Agriculture.

Right to Farm:

We support the Right to Farm legislation as a method of maintaining an environment in rural Idaho that allows the generally accepted best management practices for production agriculture to occur and be used by Idaho producers.

Industry Relations

<u>Agriculture Natural Resource Industry – Political Action Committee –</u> ANRI-PAC:

We support the ANRI-PAC for Idaho agriculture and recommend that the Idaho Hay Association, Inc. maintain a position on the board of directors of ANRI-PAC to represent Idaho hay producers in determining support of state political candidates who endorse the needs of the agriculture industry/co-ops and the members we represent.

Monetary and Tax Policy

Agriculture Economics Study:

We support a periodic economic study by the University of Idaho, College of Agriculture, Department of Agriculture Economics and Rural Sociology to assess the full impact of Idaho agriculture's contribution to Idaho's economy with all multiplier effects considered. We further support that the findings from this study be made known to members of the Idaho Legislature, state leaders and the general public in explaining the impact of agriculture on our state's economy.

Bond Levy:

We support a two-thirds majority as a requirement to pass a bond levv.

Sales Tax vs. Property Tax:

We support evaluation and study of the feasibility and fiscal impact to Idaho agriculture producers by substituting sales tax on production equipment in lieu of personal property tax on production equipment.

Natural Resources/Energy

Dam Breaching:

We support efforts to maintain the current system of dams on the Columbia and Snake River as an efficient and effective way to handle Idaho water and for the value of transportation of Idaho commodities on the rivers.

Clean Water Act:

We support the agriculture industry's commitment to reducing non-point source pollution. We support voluntary nutrient/pesticide management. We encourage all agriculture interests to use Best Management Practices as guidelines for protecting our water. We support re-authorization of the Clean Water Act and encourage the Idaho congressional delegation to work to ensure that the Act recognizes agriculture's progressive history of pollution abatement.

Labor

Minimum Wage:

We support compliance with state and federal minimum wage laws. Due to the nature of on-the-farm labor tasks, we support the exclusion of piecework from the minimum wage requirements.

Transportation

Railroad Access:

We support federal legislation mandating that railroads provide competitive access by captive railroad shippers to the nearest competitive railroad. We further support close government scrutiny of all US and Canadian railroad operations to protect the users and consumers of commodities/ products transported by rail. We further support the maintenance of short-line systems throughout Idaho as a method of moving products from rural communities to the mainline systems.

Truck Weights:

We support the increase of maximum truck weights in Idaho to 129,000 pounds on additional designated routes providing access to the federal interstate system to determine the impact on roads.. We further support that these trucks meet all established requirements for proper axle weight distribution formulas. We further support the elimination of the federal highway fee on maximum gross vehicle weight limits to allow a more equal and fair interstate system of vehicle weights.

Ton Mile Tax:

We support registration fees to replace the ton-mile tax only if an agriculture/non-commercial registration category for hauling an individual's own product they produce is available.





The IACSC assists in funding two projects that they feel are a great benefit to producers in Idaho. Here is a quick overview of both projects.

Pacific Northwest Pest Alert Network | pnwpestalert.net

- The Pacific Northwest Pest Alert Network began 16 years ago. Website subscribers are using 5.98% less pesticides on their crops than they were before they used the pest alert network.
- In 2016, the more prominent alerts pertained to psyllid, corn earworm, iris yellow spot virus, barley yellow dwarf virus, and regulatory announcements.
- PNWPestAlert.net is clearly providing useful information to the agriculture industry and is helping to save growers time and money while benefitting the environment. A journal article describing the network's impact was published in the journal of the National Association of County Ag Agents at http://www.nacaa.com/journal/index.php?jid=659.

Idaho One Plan - PAR | ONEPLAN.ORG/PAR

- The Idaho One Plan Pesticide Applicator Recordkeeping (PAR) Program is an online record-keeping tool for producers and commercial applicators.
- Producers are using PAR to better manage pesticide applications per field.
- We are now beginning to see improved pesticide management, thus reducing impacts to the environment.
- A year-end survey was used to measure impacts: 80% found PAR useful, 60% increased their compliance with pesticide requirements, 80% used it to keep permanent records for farm management, and 90% would recommend the program to a colleague.


