New District Creation Report:

The New District Creation Committee recommends that Idaho FFA add a new district, named the High Desert District adding the Salmon, Leadore, Clark, West Jefferson, Challis, Mackay, Idaho Technical Career Academy, Butte County (Arco) and Carey schools.

Committee felt competition was more fair and gave more opportunities for smaller districts, giving their students opportunities to compete and become district officers.

Membership Constitution Change Committee Report

Membership Constitution change recommends that we amend article 3 section B of the Idaho FFA Constitution to strike out 7th and insert 5th grade. Membership Constitution Change requests the board of directors to look at creating more CDE and LDE and award opportunities for 5th-8th grades. Resolution was passed by the delegate body with a two-thirds vote.

Recommending any student in agricultural or AFNR course to become an FFA member, aligns with the National Constitution and regulations. All FFA members would be able to compete.

Idaho FFA VIP Award Committee Report

Idaho FFA VIP Award recommends that we add the VIP award with the following terms: they have 15 years of unobligated service, excludes advisors, cannot be an active member. Resolution was passed with over a two-thirds vote.
